

Creating an Amigurumi Ball

Measurements: (circumference)

Small : 15 -16 cm

Medium : 19 - 20 cm

Large : 23 - 24 cm

Materials:

Worsted weight yarn in the desired color(s)

Crochet hook appropriate for your yarn.

Fiberfill or stuffing

Yarn needle

Note: I am using Alize Sekerim Baby with a crochet hook size 3.0mm. When you change the yarn and hook size, the size of the ball changes along with it.

Pattern Note: This pattern is worked in continuous rounds, without joining at the end of each round.

Small Size:



Round 1: Create a magic ring, and work 6 single crochet (sc) stitches into the ring. Pull the ring tight to close. (6 stitches)

Round 2: Work 2 sc in each stitch around. (12 stitches)

Round 3: 2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next stitch Repeat from * to * around. (18 stitches)

Round 4: Sc in next stitch, 2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next stitch Repeat from * to * around. (24 stitches)

Round 5: 2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next 3 stitches Repeat from * to * around. (30 stitches)

Round 6-11: Sc in each stitch around. (30 stitches)

Begin stuffing the ball with fiberfill or stuffing, making sure to stuff firmly but not overstuff.

Round 12: *Sc2tog (single crochet 2 together) in the next stitch, Sc in the next 3 stitches*
Repeat from * to * around. (24 stitches)

Round 13: *Sc in next stitch, Sc2tog in next stitch, Sc in next stitch* Repeat from * to * around. (18 stitches)

Round 14: *Sc2tog (single crochet 2 together) in the next stitch, Sc in the next stitch*
Repeat from * to * around. (12 stitches)

Round 15: Sc2tog around. (6 stitches)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Thread the yarn tail through the last 6 stitches and pull tight to close the remaining hole. Weave in any remaining yarn ends.

Medium Size:



Round 1: Create a magic ring, and work 6 single crochet (sc) stitches into the ring. Pull the ring tight to close. (6 stitches)

Round 2: Work 2 sc in each stitch around. (12 stitches)

Round 3: *2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next stitch* Repeat from * to * around. (18 stitches)

Round 4: *Sc in next stitch, 2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next stitch* Repeat from * to * around. (24 stitches)

Round 5: *2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next 3 stitches* Repeat from * to * around. (30 stitches)

Round 6: *Sc in the next 2 stitches, 2 Sc in the next stitch, Sc in the next 2 stitches*
Repeat from * to * around. (36 stitches)

Round 7: *2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next 5 stitches* Repeat from * to * around. (42 stitches)

Round 8-17: Sc in each stitch around. (42 stitches)

Begin stuffing the ball with fiberfill or stuffing, making sure to stuff firmly but not overstuffed.

Round 18: *Sc2tog (single crochet 2 together) in the next stitch, Sc in the next 5 stitches*
Repeat from * to * around. (36 stitches)

Round 19: *Sc in next 2 stitches, Sc2tog in next stitch, Sc in next 2 stitches* Repeat from * to * around. (30 stitches)

Round 20: *Sc2tog (single crochet 2 together) in the next stitch, Sc in the next 3 stitches* Repeat from * to * around. (24 stitches)

Round 21: *Sc in next stitch, Sc2tog in next stitch, Sc in next stitch* Repeat from * to * around. (18 stitches)

Round 22: *Sc2tog (single crochet 2 together) in the next stitch, Sc in the next stitch* Repeat from * to * around. (12 stitches)

Round 23: Sc2tog around. (6 stitches)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Thread the yarn tail through the last 6 stitches and pull tight to close the remaining hole. Weave in any remaining yarn ends.

Large Size:



Round 1: Create a magic ring, and work 6 single crochet (sc) stitches into the ring. Pull the ring tight to close. (6 stitches)

Round 2: Work 2 sc in each stitch around. (12 stitches)

Round 3: *2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next stitch* Repeat from * to * around. (18 stitches)

Round 4: *Sc in next stitch, 2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next stitch* Repeat from * to * around. (24 stitches)

Round 5: *2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next 3 stitches* Repeat from * to * around. (30 stitches)

Round 6: *Sc in the next 2 stitches, 2 Sc in the next stitch, Sc in the next 2 stitches*

Repeat from * to * around. (36 stitches)

Round 7: *2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next 5 stitches* Repeat from * to * around. (42

stitches) Round 8: *Sc in the next 3 stitches, 2 Sc in the next stitch, Sc in the next 3 stitches*

Repeat from * to * around. (48 stitches)

Round 9: *2 sc in next stitch, Sc in next 7 stitches* Repeat from * to * around. (54

stitches) Round 10-21: Sc in each stitch around. (54 stitches)

Begin stuffing the ball with fiberfill or stuffing, making sure to stuff firmly but not overstuffed.

Round 22: *Sc2tog (single crochet 2 together) in the next stitch, Sc in the next 7 stitches* Repeat from * to * around. (48 stitches)

Round 23: *Sc in the next 3 stitches, Sc2tog in the next stitch, Sc in the next 3 stitches*

Repeat from * to * around. (42 stitches)

Round 24: *Sc2tog (single crochet 2 together) in the next stitch, Sc in the next 5 stitches*

Repeat from * to * around. (36 stitches)

Round 25: *Sc in the next 2 stitches, Sc2tog in the next stitch, Sc in the next 2 stitches*
Repeat from * to * around. (30 stitches)

Round 26: *Sc2tog (single crochet 2 together) in the next stitch, Sc in the next 3 stitches*
Repeat from * to * around. (24 stitches)

Round 27: *Sc in the next stitch, Sc2tog in the next stitch, Sc in the next stitch* Repeat from * to * around. (18 stitches)

Round 28: *Sc2tog (single crochet 2 together) in the next stitch, Sc in the next stitch*
Repeat from * to * around. (12 stitches)

Round 29: Sc2tog around. (6 stitches)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Thread the yarn tail through the last 6 stitches and pull tight to close the remaining hole. Weave in any remaining yarn ends.

And that's it! You now have a simple amigurumi round ball that you can use as a base for various projects, such as toys, ornaments, or decorations. You can customize the ball by using different colors, adding embellishments, or using different yarn types to create different textures. Happy crocheting!
