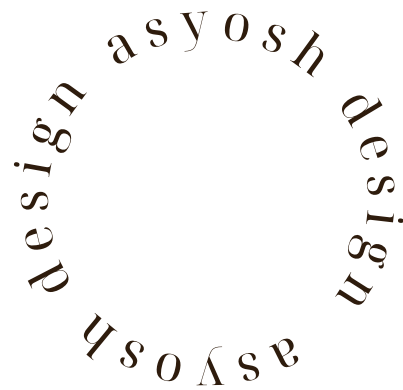


CROCHET DRAWSTRING POUCH PATTERN BY ASYOSH



Crochet Drawstring Pouch

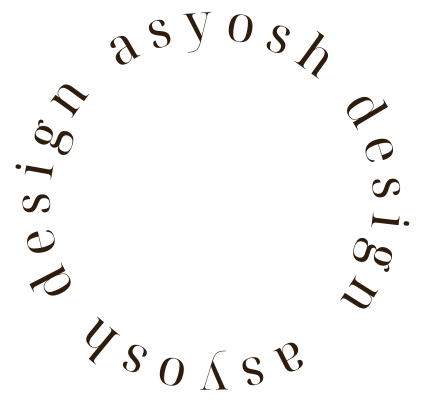
Keep your small treasures safe and stylish with this charming crochet drawstring pouch pattern! Use it to create adorable pouches for jewelry, little things, or gift wrapping!

This pattern requires intermediate crochet skills and knowledge of basic stitches.

*The patterns are presented in **US crochet terminology.**



Helpful Tips



Pattern Specifics:

Familiarize yourself with basic crochet stitches such as double crochet (dc), slip stitch (Sl st), and chain (ch) before starting.

Tailor to Your Taste:

Adjust the yarn weight and hook size to achieve your preferred texture and size for the pouches . This customization ensures your project aligns perfectly with your vision.

For this project, you can use either 4-ply or 6-ply yarn, depending on your desired thickness and final result. Both options work well.

Embrace Creativity:

Experiment with different colors and yarn types to craft pouches that are as unique as you are.

Personal Touch:

You can use some embellishments to personalize it. For example, you can find the coaster patterns for perfect personalized pouches with in my store.

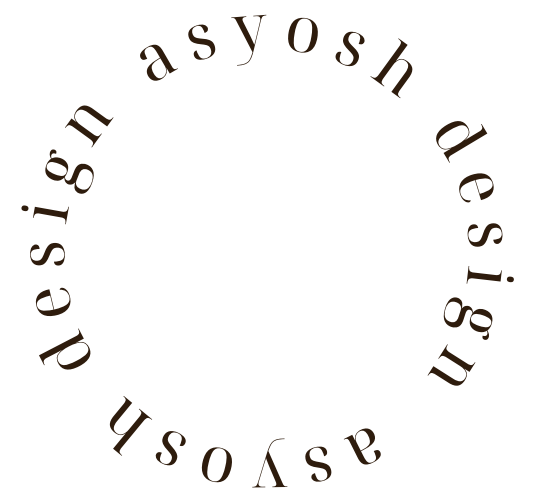
Materials

- Yarns (4 ply)
- Crochet Hooks – Size 3 mm
- Scissors



Stitches and Abbreviation

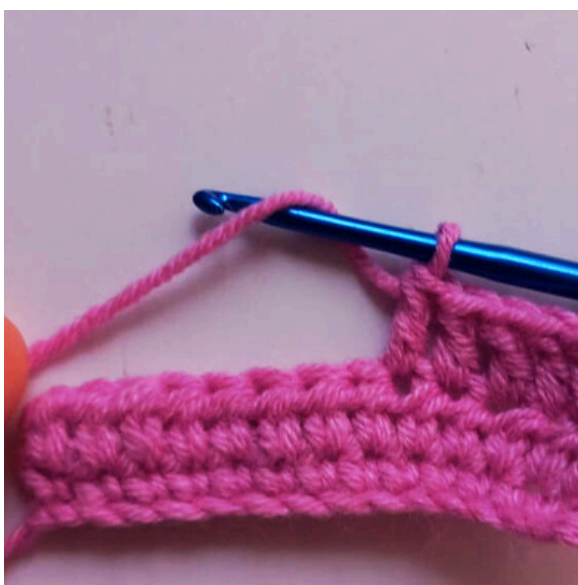
- [Slip Knot](#)*
- [ch – chain stitch](#)*
- [Sl st – slip stitch](#)*
- [dc – double crochet](#)*
- [inc – increase](#)

Double Crochet (dc)

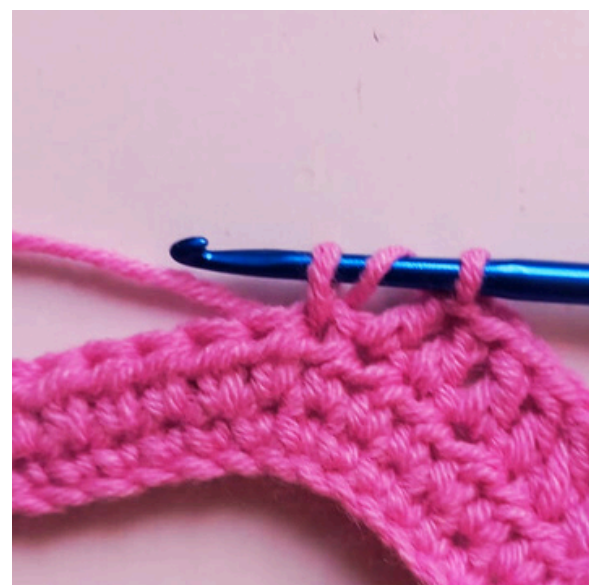
Yarn over ones insert your hook in to the next stitch, yarn over pull through that stitch, yarn over pull through two, yarn over pull through two



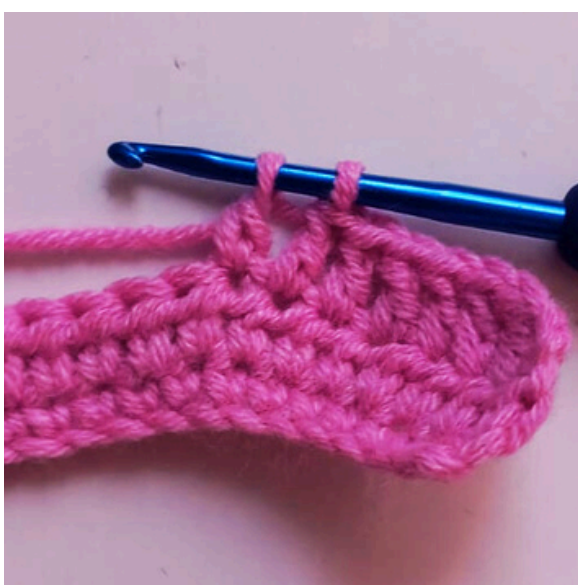

Crochet Drawstring Pouch

Step-by-Step Pattern

- Make a slip knot and ch 30
- **Row 1:** Start from 3rd ch, dc 27, dc 2 in same ch (inc), dc 27, Sl st in first dc (56)
- **Row 2-20:** ch 2, (dc 1 in every stitch)*56 , Sl St in first dc (56)
- **Row 21:** ch 2, dc 1, (ch 3, skip 2 stitch, dc 1 in 3rd and 4th stitches)*13, ch 3, skip 2 stitch, dc 1 in 3rd stitch, Sl st in first dc (Totally 14 ch-3 gap)
- **Row 22:** ch 2, dc 1 in first dc, (dc 2 in ch-3 gap, dc 1 in following 2 dc)*13, dc 2 in ch-3 gap, dc 1, Sl st (56)
- **Row 23:** ch 2, (dc 1 in every stitch)*56 , Sl St in first dc (56)
- **Row 24:** ch 2, (dc 2 in same stitch (inc))*56, Sl st in first dc (112), ch 1, cut and fasten off the yarn

Rope

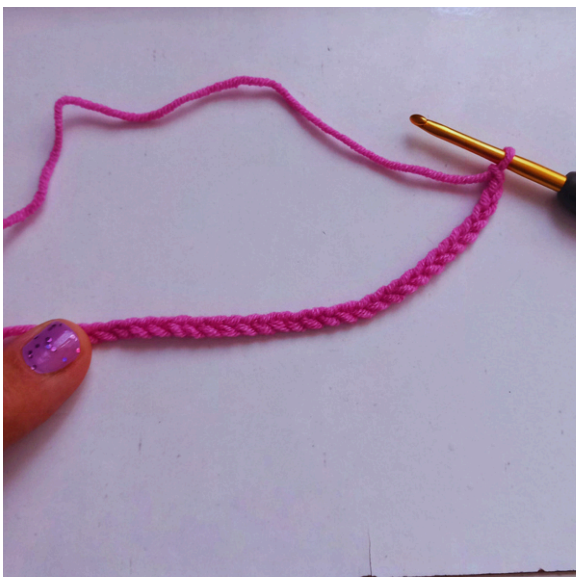
- Make a slip knot and ch 120
- **Row 1:** Start in 3rd ch, (dc 1 in every stitch)*118, ch 1, cut and fasten off the yarn(118)



Make a slip knot and ch 30

Row 1: Start from 3rd ch, dc 27, dc 2 in same ch(inc), dc 27, Sl st in first dc (56)



Skip 2 ch, and start from 3rd ch



dc 1 in 3rd ch



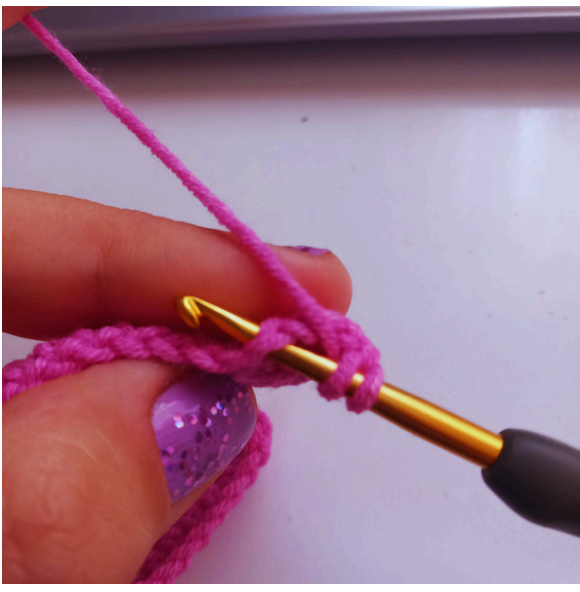
Totally dc 27

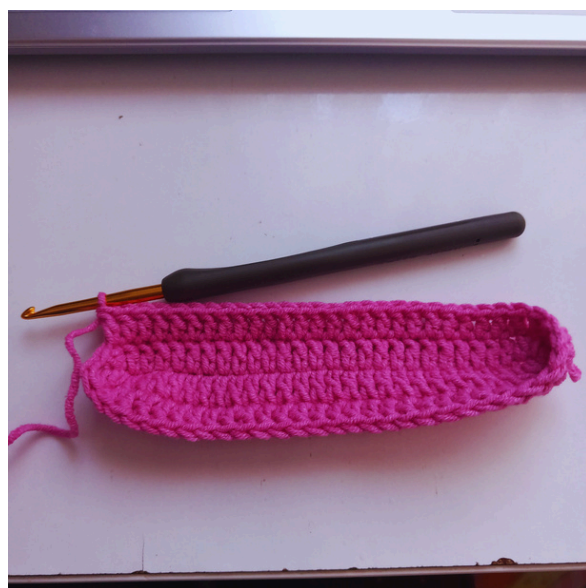
Row 2-20: ch 2, (dc 1 in every stitch)*56 , Sl St in first dc (56)

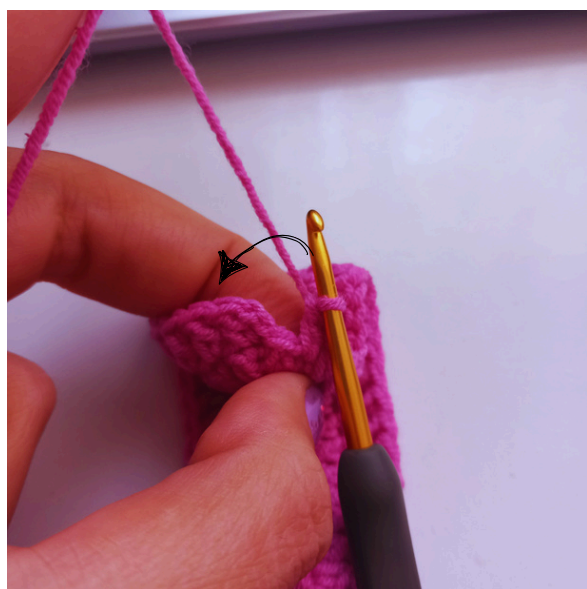

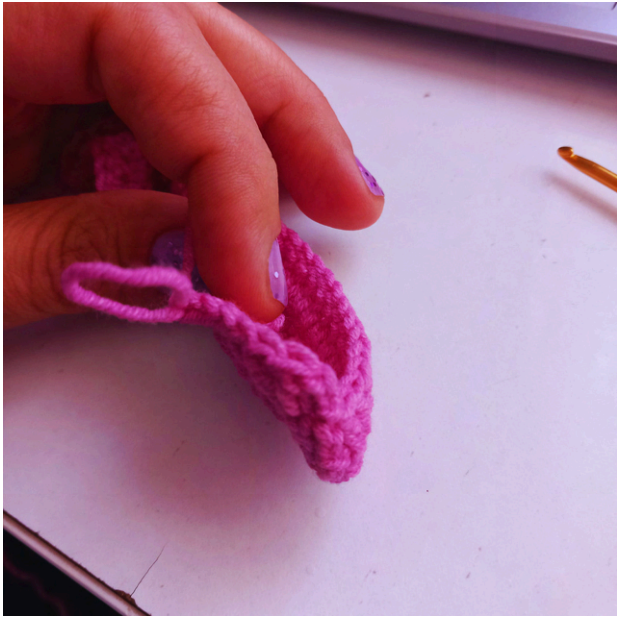

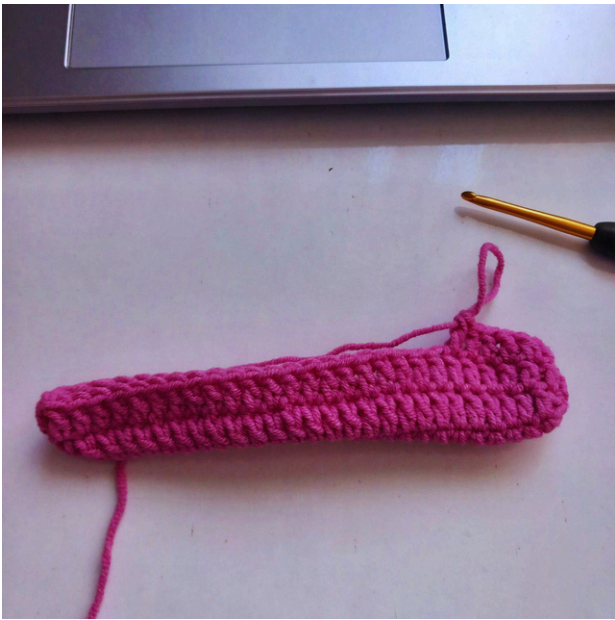

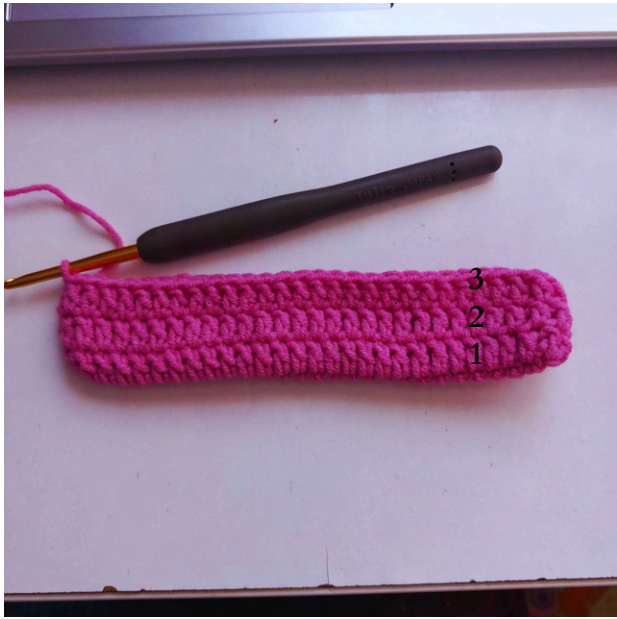

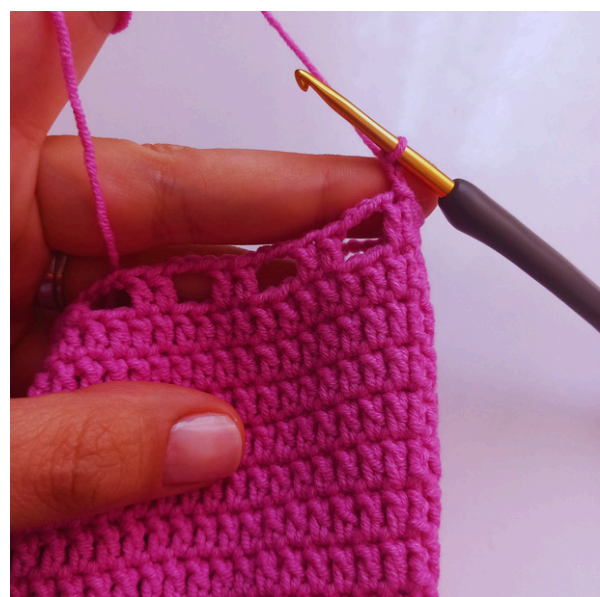

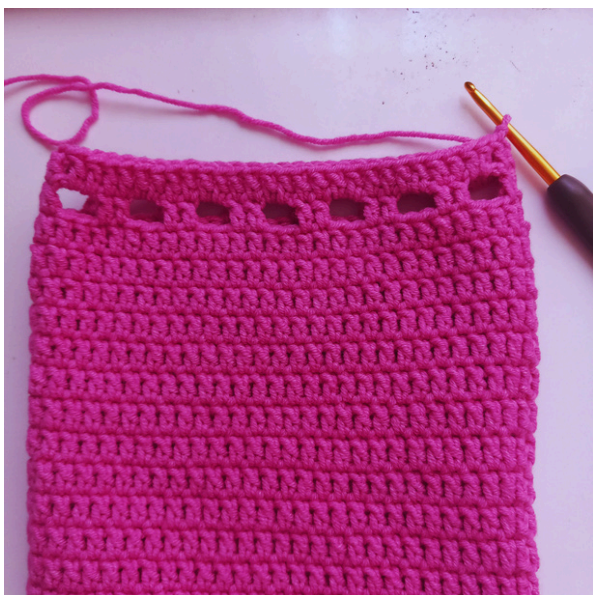

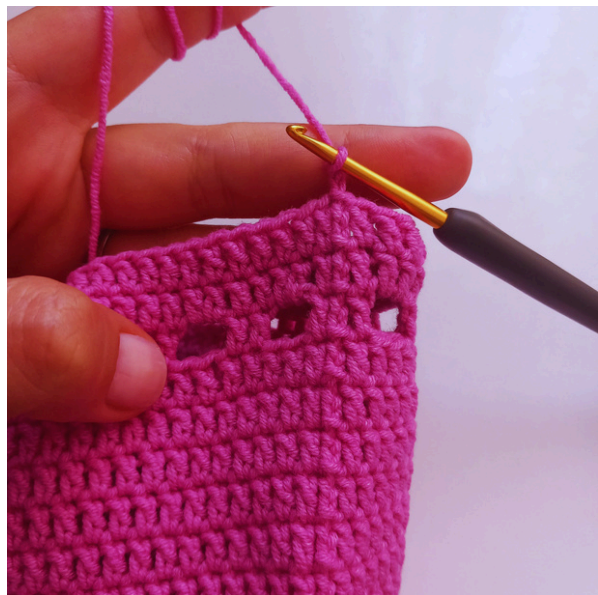

Row 24: ch 2, (dc 2 in same stitch (inc))*56, Sl st in first dc (112), ch 1, cut and fasten off the yarn

ROPE

Make a slip knot and ch 120

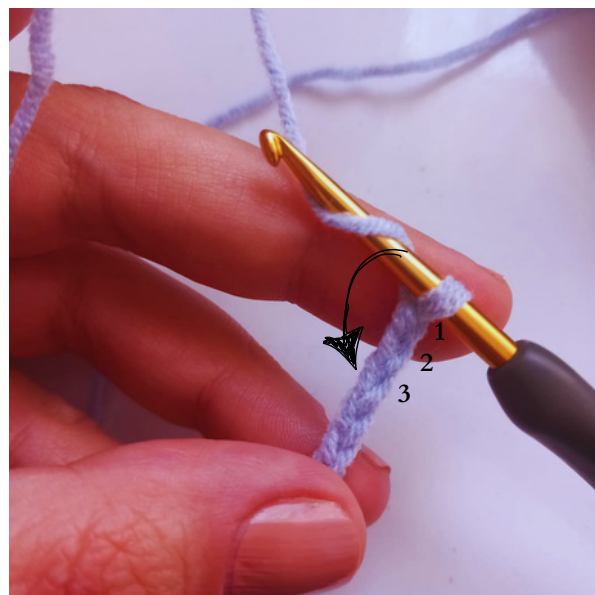


Slip Knot

Row 1: Start in 3rd ch, (dc 1 in every stitch)*118, ch 1, cut and fasten off the yarn(118)

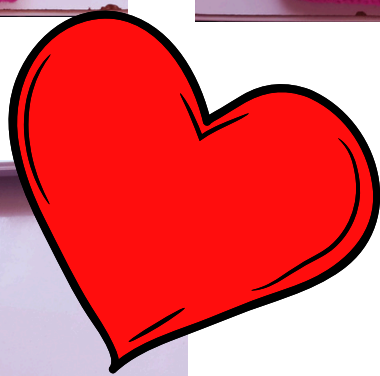
