Catechetical Corner

Catholic teaching on "Chatty Catholics":

The protocol for talking in the Catholic sanctuary and main church nave before and after Mass is to maintain **sacred silence**. Socializing should be moved to the vestibule or outside to respect those praying and to honor the Real Presence in the tabernacle.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal recommends silence before Mass to prepare, and tradition encourages it afterward for thanksgiving.

So let us reserve our socializing to the narthex and our silence to the Sanctuary out of respect for God and others.
